































Tying the rope Christ our Saviour Parish

















































































































Servers at the Mass

- You should be at church 15 minutes or more before the start of the mass
- Altar servers should be careful with their vestments and choose the correct size



Servers at the Mass

- clean clothes and clean footwear
- Clean hands and fingernails
- Participate in the mass
- refrain from talking with the other altar server or with family/friends in the pews
- Listen and be attentive



Servers at the Mass

- Keep your hands on your lap or together in front of you if standing
- Both feet should be on the floor (legs should not be crossed)
- If you must yawn, cover your mouth
- If you do need to tend to bodily needs (bathroom, runny nose, cough etc.) let the other server know you will return, and leave quietly and return quietly



Servers at Mass

- you are responsible to replace yourself.
- A list of volunteers is with the schedule
- Once you have found a replacement, let the mass coordinators for those dates, know of the changes
