Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

"Jesus said to them: "Come follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." At once they left their nets and followed him.

-Matthew 4:19

Reflection: Today's Gospel invites us to reflect on the baptism of Jesus and on our own baptism John the Baptist helps us to understand the mission of Jesus by clearly proclaiming that Jesus "is the lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world," a truth that we also proclaim at every Mass. Yet what does that mean today in a world that often denies the reality of sin, even when its harmful impact is all around us?

We cannot honestly face our individual and collective human failures unless we are convinced that we too are meant to take to heart the words that Jesus heard at his own baptism. Yes, we too are "the beloved" in whom God takes delight. This is the deepest meaning of our own baptism. We can never be separated for any reason whatever from the love of God for us. This love is an unconditional gift and unearned grace beyond all measure. Once we claim this truth for ourselves with honesty and confidence, we can, with gratitude, face our need for forgiveness, trusting we will always receive it.

This week let us pray for Christian unity, a unity which is rooted in the common baptism we share with all the Christians. May we live out faithfully, day by day, our baptismal mission to reveal God's love to our broken, messy world.



